## The Choice of Readings

For Memorials and Optional Memorials the Weekday Readings have been chosen. There are other options to this: see the G.I.R.M., paragraphs 357-358, for the norms on the choice of Readings. Sundays, Solemnities and Feasts have their own proper Readings. The exception to this arrangement for Memorials is made when the Scripture mentions, by name, the Saint being celebrated. Otherwise, the Readings may be found in the Lectionary.

The Gradual is sung after the First Reading at Mass. The Proper Gradual for each day can be found in *Divine Worship: The Missal*. On Ferias use the Gradual of the preceding Sunday.

The Tract is only said on Sundays in Pre-Lent and Lent, on Ash Wednesday, on the Monday after the First Sunday of Lent, on Ember Days in the First Week of Lent or wherever as appointed in *Divine Worship: The Missal*.

On Solemnities and Feasts, the Gradual is found in the Propers of the Day, or from the Common. On Memorials, the Gradual may be taken either from the Common, the Proper (if there is one), or use the Gradual from the preceding Sunday. During such Liturgical Seasons as the 17-23 December and during Lent, these Graduals tie in very closely with the themes of the rest of the Liturgy on their given days.

Should the choice be made to use the Responsorial Psalm instead of the Gradual, it can be found in the Lectionary for the appointed day. The reference for the Responsorial Psalm has not been given in this Ordo. The Responsorial Psalm may replace the Gradual.

## Memorials on the Weekdays of Lent

Memorials, whether obligatory or optional, may be commemorated on the weekdays of Lent, by using the Collect of the Memorial. All other parts of the Office and Mass are proper to the day. Violet vestments are worn. The Memorial therefore becomes an optional *Commemoration*.
